- Report of Last Year's Expenditures
 - Anticipated funding for a Para Salary/Social Security wasn't used and needs to be reallocated
- Positive Behavior Interventions (PBIS) - Mr Christensen
 - Student Referrals - ask teachers to nominate students who would not normally be recognized for their achievements during sports, drama, music, etc by sending in 1-2 sentences about them. Call the students to his office on Fridays and give them a small reward and then calls their parents to share what the teacher wrote.
 - Character Ed/School of Life - Taught 3 times/year, 4 consecutive Tuesday afternoons from 3-5 with groups of 17 students. It is taught by the Interventionist. Usually Trust funds would pay for this, but this year the district is covering the cost. First class starts this afternoon.
- School Safety/COVID - Mr Bair

- COVID - information/requirements change rapidly. Only 3 confirmed cases at DHS, but 2 at once. Overall students are good about wearing their masks.
- Safety - continuing to add cameras/improve quality of cameras
 - Noted - could potentially use some of the extra trust funds for the additional cameras.
 - Fire drills have been suspended to keep a large group of students assembling as they exit the building.
- School Schedules - Mr Brooks
 - Volleyball & Football have State Playoffs, Winter Sports are starting, Parent-Teacher Conferences are scheduled next week, but are only encouraging parents to come in if their student is struggling to minimize the number of people and spacing, Choir has a concert but still determining the location/timing since the weather turned cold and the plan was to hold it outside.
